In Osaka International Music Competition, year 2018, Sinjo's had gained herself an Espoir Prize. In addition, she received the 2<sup>nd</sup> prize in Euroasia String Competition held in 2019. She own the 2<sup>nd</sup> prize in 8th David Popper International Cello Competition held in Hungary despite being the youngest cellist in her category.
